


Enabling Remote Desktop on a Windows 10 PC


When working from home, you may find it necessary to access your local drives on your PC. Remote desktop provides secure access to your Windows 10 PC from anywhere using a Wi-Fi connection. In order to access your PC, you must first enable remote desktop access.

Enabling Remote Desktop

1. To enable Remote Desktop begin by opening the Settings from the Windows start menu.




2. From the Settings menu, open the System tab.




3. From the Systems menu, select Remote Desktop and switch “Enable Remote Desktop” to on.

Note: Be sure to make note of the PC name as it will be necessary when trying to connect to your PC.




Remote Desktop Access

1. In the Windows search bar type “Remote Desktop Connection” and select the Remote Desktop Connection App.



2. The Remote Desktop Connection screen will open and you can enter the name of the PC you want to connect to.
